**ORDER TO PLAINTIFF TO SHOW

On November 7, 2011, Plaintiff Reynaldo Ortega filed his Complaint for damages and injunctive relief against multiple defendants related to the refinance and subsequent foreclosure of property located in Bakersfield, California.
