The Court may dismiss Plaintiff's complaint or a portion thereof if the court determines 21 that the action is legally "frivolous or malicious," fails to state a claim upon which relief may be granted, or seeks monetary relief from a defendant who is immune from such relief. 28 U.S.C. § 22 1915(e)(2); see also Omar v.
