The defendants approximately \$7,624.85 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant currency"), approximately \$6,099.37 in U.S. Currency seized from River City Bank account number 1810009790, and approximately \$17,316.20 in U.S. Currency seized from Wells Fargo Bank account number 8123978010 (hereafter collectively "defendant funds"), were seized on or about May 25, 2011, at 16044 Via Este Road in Sonora, California and 3020 Floyd Avenue in Modesto, California, respectively and are in the custody of the U.S. Marshals Service, Eastern District of California.
