order Defendants to "restore to the Plaintiff the 12" of legal documents and evidence which was

confiscated on or about May 8, 2012." (Doc. 24 at 2). However, the persons named in Plaintiff's motion are not the same individuals named as defendants in his case. (Doc. 1, Doc. 24). As set forth above, the Court has yet to screen Plaintiff's complaint. Thus, the Defendants have not been served and the Court does not have jurisdiction over any of the individually named Defendants or additional persons name in Plaintiff's motion. Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's December 26, 2012 motion for return of documents (Doc. 24) is DENIED AS PREMATURE. IT IS SO ORDERED. Dated: **December 28, 2012** /s/ Jennifer L.
