Compl. 14 at 5-6, 8, Doc. 1. 15 On August 22, 2012, Plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal of this action pursuant to 16 17 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A). An action may be dismissed by a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). Plaintiff is the 18 19 only party to appear in this action. Pursuant to this notice, the Court HEREBY ORDERS the Clerk 20 of Court to close this action.
