



1 On September 4, 2014, the Court received a notice of change of address from Plaintiff.  
2 In the notice, Plaintiff states that he has been incarcerated on misdemeanor charges and has not  
3 been receiving mail.

4 Accordingly, as it is unclear whether Plaintiff received the prior orders, the Clerk of  
5 Court is DIRECTED to reserve Documents 27 and 28 on Plaintiff at his new address.

6 The Court will extend the time for filing objections to the Findings and  
7 Recommendations thirty days from the date of service of this order.

8 Plaintiff is informed that failure to file objections to the July 31, 2014, Findings and  
9 Recommendations will result in dismissal of this action.
