20	Findings and Recommendations recommending that Defendant's motion to dismiss be denied as	
21	moot. (ECF No. 55.) The Findings and Recommendations were served on all parties and contained notice that	
22	The Findings and Recommendations were served on all parties and contained notice that any objections were to be filed within thirty (30) days. Neither party has filed objections to the	
23	Findings and Recommendations.	
24 25	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a	
25 26	\underline{de} <u>novo</u> review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the	
26 27	Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis. In this case,	
27	Defendant's motion to dismiss was mooted by the Court's screening order dismissing Plaintiff's
