



1 relief may be granted, or that seek monetary relief from a defendant who is immune from  
2 such relief. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b)(1),(2).

3 The Court is aware of Plaintiff's action and his First Amended Complaint is in line  
4 for screening. However, the Court has a large number of prisoner civil rights cases pending  
5 before it and will screen Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint in due course. Until such time  
6 as the Court has screened Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint, no further action is required  
7 of Plaintiff. The Court will not direct service of summons by the United States Marshal  
8 absent a pleading containing cognizable claims for relief against the named Defendants.  
9 Plaintiff will have an opportunity to raise discovery and evidentiary matters at any  
10 appropriate time subsequent to service.

11 Accordingly, for the foregoing reasons, it is ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion to  
12 Compel Discovery (Mot. to Compel, ECF No. 15), Motion to Verify Parties (Mot. to Verify,  
13 ECF No. 16), Motion to Designate Records (Mot. to Designate R., ECF No. 17), and  
14 Summons Motion (Summons Mot., ECF No. 18) are DENIED.
