20	the Eighth Amendment. Defendant filed an answer on January 21, 2014, and the Court issued a		
21	scheduling order on February 3, 2014.

24	inability to litigate this case. On February 19, 2014, Defendant filed a statement of non-opposition		
25	and requested that the Court extend all scheduling order deadlines, should it grant Plaintiff's
