7	the money orders to the Court no later than August 30, 2019. In order to ensure
8	timely submission of the money orders, Plaintiff must notify the Court of the
9	names and locations of his witnesses no later than July 30, 2019.
10	7. Plaintiff's pretrial statement is due on or before July 30, 2019.
11	8. Defendants' pretrial statement is due on or before August 30, 2019.
12	9. The Telephonic Trial Confirmation Hearing is set for September 30, 2019, at 2:30
13	p.m.
14	10. The Trial is set for December 3, 2019, at 1:00 p.m.
