

1 parties and contained notice that objections thereto were to be filed within thirty days. (*Id.*) On
2 February 10, 2017, plaintiff timely filed objections. (Doc. No. 68.)

3 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a
4 *de novo* review of the matter. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, including plaintiff's
5 objections, the court finds that the findings and recommendations are supported by the record and
6 proper analysis.

7 Accordingly,

- 8 1. The January 9, 2017 findings and recommendations (Doc. No. 67) are adopted in full;
- 9 2. This action shall proceed on the following claims:
 - 10 a. A claim of deliberate indifference under the Eighth Amendment, against
 - 11 defendants Medina, Chudy, and Frederichs;
 - 12 b. A claim under the Bane Act against defendant Medina; and
 - 13 c. Claims for retaliation under the First Amendment and the Bane Act, against
 - 14 defendants Eddings and Walker;
- 15 3. All remaining claims and defendants are dismissed from this action. Specifically, all
- 16 of plaintiff's other federal claims alleged in his third amended complaint are dismissed
- 17 with prejudice, and all other state claims are dismissed without prejudice but without
- 18 further leave to amend.
