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13	Plaintiff Richard Charles Hanna is a	appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil	
14	rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate		
15	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.		
16	On June 5 2014, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations		
17	recommending granting in part Defendants' motion to dismiss on the grounds of res judicata		
18	which was served on the parties and which contained notice to the parties that any objections to		
19	the Findings and Recommendations were to be filed within thirty days. On July 2, 2014, Plaintiff		
20	filed an Objection. On July 3, 2014, Defendants filed a response to Plaintiff's objection.		
21	Plaintiff's objections are not persuasive. In the main, Plaintiff's objections are a		
22	reiteration of his attempts to set aside the judgment in related case 1:12cv1885 AWI SAB.		
23	However, the issue of whether the judgment should be set aside has been decided, and the		
24	judgment in 1:12cv1885 AWI SAB will not l	be set aside. Plaintiff presented evidence at a hearing	
25 25	and objected to the Magistrate Judge's finding	ngs and recommendation. The Court considered the	
26 27	findings and recommendation, the evidence, and Plaintiff's objections and it ruled against		
27	Plaintiff. The Court will not entertain further motions or argument on the topic.		
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1	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a		
2	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the		
3	Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.		
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5	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:		
6	1.	The Findings and Recommendations, filed June 5, 2014, is ADOPTED IN FULL;	
7	2.	The Motion to Dismiss filed December 31, 2013 is GRANTED IN PART and	
8		DENIED IN PART as follows:	
9	a.	Defendants' motion to dismiss on the basis of res judicata is GRANTED as to	
10		Defendant Mariposa County Sheriff Department, and DENIED as to Defendants	
11		Boehm, Rumfelt, Rameriz, and King;	
12	b.	Defendants' motion to dismiss for improper service on the individual Defendants	
13		is GRANTED, and the United States Marshal shall be ordered to re-serve the	
14		summons and complaint;	
15	с.	Defendants' motion to dismiss the punitive damages claim against Defendant	
16		Mariposa County Sheriff Department is GRANTED;	
17	d.	Defendants' motion to dismiss on all other grounds is DENIED; and	
18	3.	This action is referred back to the magistrate judge to initiate service of process on	
19		Defendants Boehm, Rumfelt, Rameriz, and King.	
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21	IT IS SO ORDERED.
