16	On April 8, 2014, Plaintiff Akheem Williams, who is proceeding pro se in this action, filed
17	a letter notifying the Court of his change of address to the Kings County Jail. ¹ However, the letter
18	was not signed. Filings must include the original signature of the filing party, Fed. R. Civ. P.
19	11(a); Local Rule 131, and all documents submitted without the required signature are stricken,
20	Doc. 3, First Informational Order, ¶2.
21	In light of Plaintiff's failure to sign his filing, it is HEREBY ORDERED STRICKEN from
22	the record, which renders it a nullity.
