The Findings and Recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice that any objections were to be filed within thirty (30) days. Over thirty days have passed and no 22 23

party has filed objections. However, on October 24, 2014, Plaintiff filed a motion to dismiss Defendant Marisol from the action without prejudice.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
