23 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties through their undersigned
 24 counsel, subject to the approval of the Court, that Plaintiff be awarded attorney fees under the
 25 EAJA in the amount of SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE dollars and 0 cents (\$675.00). This
 26 amount represents compensation for all legal services rendered on behalf of Plaintiff, to date, by
 27 counsel in connection with this civil action, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 2412.

28 This stipulation constitutes a compromise settlement of Plaintiff's request for EAJA
 attorney fees and expenses, and does not constitute an admission of liability on the part of
 Defendant under the EAJA. Payment of the agreed amount shall constitute a complete release
 from, and bar to, any and all claims that Plaintiff and/or Plaintiff's counsel may have relating to
 EAJA attorney fees and expenses in connection with this action.

1 Following the issuance of an order by the Court, the United States Department of the
2 Treasury will determine whether Plaintiff owes a government debt and take appropriate action
3 according to its own statutes and regulations, as permitted by Astrue v. Ratliff, 130 S.Ct. 2521
4 (2010). If no debt is owed, then the Government will accept Plaintiff's assignment of EAJA fees
5 and make the check payable to the Law Offices of Lawrence D. Rohlfing, counsel for Plaintiff.

6 This award is without prejudice to the rights of Plaintiff's counsel to seek Social Security
7 Act attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406, subject to the offset provisions of the EAJA.
