No objections 22 23 were filed. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and 25 26 Recommendation to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 27 /// 28 ///
