Plaintiff Eric Wheeler (“Plaintiff”) is a prisoner in the custody of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (“CDCR”). Plaintiff is proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds on Plaintiff’s complaint, filed on May 25, 2012, on the following claims: (1) excessive force in violation of the Eighth Amendment against Defendants Duck, Murrieta and Lowder; (2) failure to protect in violation of the Eighth Amendment against Defendants Duck, Murrieta, Lowder, Loftis and Alison; and (3) deliberate indifference to a serious medical in violation of the Eighth Amendment against Defendants Ross, Mui, Neubarth and Ancheta.

Defendant Murrieta, Lowder, Loftis, Duck, Ancheta, Neubarth, Ross and Allison’s January 20, 2015, motion for summary judgment is pending.

1 On January 29, 2015, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting that this Court issue an order to
2 Mule Creek State Prison Facility B Law Librarian to allow Plaintiff to make up to 40 copies of
3 28-lined paper per week. In a request for additional time to oppose the motion for summary
4 judgment, filed with the instant motion, Plaintiff suggests that he needs the copies for his
5 opposition.

6 This Court does not, however, have authority over individuals who are not parties to this
7 action, and it cannot order such individuals to take any action. Plaintiff states that he has filed an
8 inmate appeal about the issue, and the Court will not intervene in the process.

10 While the Court prefers pleadings on 28-lined paper, Plaintiff may submit his filings on
11 regular paper if necessary.
