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17 Plaintiff Eric Wheeler (“Plaintiff”) is a prisoner in the custody of the California
18 Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (“CDCR”). Plaintiff is proceeding pro se and in
19 forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds on
20 Plaintiff’s complaint, filed on May 25, 2012.

21 On January 21, 2015, the Court issued an order to show cause to Defendants why
22 sanctions should not be imposed for failing to comply with the discovery order. The order
23 permitted a response from Defendants within fourteen days.

24 On February 4, 2015, Defendants provided their response. The Court discharged the
25 order to show cause on February 11, 2015.
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1 On February 17, 2015, the Court received a sixty-four page “reply” from Plaintiff to
2 Defendants’ response to the order to show cause. The order to show cause did not permit the
3 filing of a reply, however, and the filing is therefore DISREGARDED.
