White ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma 15 pauperis. On December 2, 2014, the Court directed the United States Marshal to serve the first 16 17 amended complaint on Defendants Pazin, Merced County Sheriff's Administration, Blake, 18 Cavallero, Scott, Thoreson, and Blodgett. (ECF No. 25.) 19 On April 13 and 17, 2015, Plaintiff filed requests for a status report on whether or not the 20 United States Marshal had completed service on all seven defendants. (ECF Nos. 26, 27.) 21 On June 16, 2015, the United States Marshal returned executed summonses for all seven 22 defendants. (ECF No. 28.) On June 23, 2015, Defendants filed a motion to dismiss. (ECF No. 23 30.) Accordingly, Plaintiff's requests for status regarding service are no longer necessary and 24 are HEREBY DENIED as moot. IT IS SO ORDERED. 25 26 Dated: **June 25, 2015** 27 28
