Plaintiff is proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis 14 in this civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On June 21, 2012, Plaintiff filed his original 15 complaint. On July 27, 2012, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting the addition of further pleadings to 16 his complaint. ECF No. 9. On August 6, 2012, Plaintiff filed a motion to clarify his complaint. 17 ECF No. 11. Plaintiff had moved to include additional pleadings concerning his religion, and to 18 clarify that he requests a trial by jury. 19 Both motions are moot. On September 11, 2012, Plaintiff filed his First Amended 20 Complaint, which has resolved both of Plaintiff's prior issues. ECF No. 13.
