ORDER VACATING ORDER DIRECTING
SERVICE AND RECALLING SERVICE
DOCUMENTS FROM UNITED STATES
MARSHAL

Plaintiff Michael Anthony Todd (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

On December 4, 2015, after the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals reversed this Court’s order dismissing the action in part, the Court ordered the United States Marshal to serve eight Defendants. Upon further review, the Court VACATES the order directing service by the United States Marshal and RECALLS the service documents. At this time, the United States Marshal need not serve any Defendants in this matter.¹
