ORDER ON DEFENDANTS' REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION

(ECF No. 127)

18 Plaintiff Earl Warner is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis
19 in this civil rights action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

20 On September 23, 2016, this Court granted Plaintiff a fourteen-day extension of
21 time to file a motion to compel. (ECF No. 124.) On September 30, 2016, Plaintiff's
22 motion to compel was filed. (ECF No. 126.) On October 4, 2016, Defendants filed the
23 instant "Request for Clarification." (ECF No. 127.) Therein, Defendants point out that the
24 CM/ECF docket text accompanying the Court's September 23, 2016 order states
25 "Discovery due by October 11, 2016." Defendants ask for an explanation of this docket
26 entry.

27 The directive "Discovery due by October 11, 2016" resulted from pure clerical
28 error. The docket text has been corrected to reflect that Plaintiff's *motion to compel*

2 discovery was due by October 11, 2016. (See ECF No. 124.)
