(Docs. 37, 40, and 42.) Although it is apparent Plaintiff seeks to change the 21 defendant, each of the proposed Third Amended Complaints are different. (Compare Doc. 38 with 22 Docs. 41 and 43.) Plaintiff is informed he may only have <u>one</u> pleading in this case, and must inform 23 the Court upon which motion he desires to proceed. The other motions to amend will be terminated by the Court. In addition, because Plaintiff no longer seeks to proceed with his claims against Chad 24 25 Garrett (see Docs. 37, 38, 40, and 43), Plaintiff is directed to show cause why his claims against 26 Officer Garret should not be dismissed with prejudice.
