Absent an appropriation, Department of Justice attorneys and employees 19 of the federal defendants are prohibited from working, even on a voluntary basis, except in very limited 20 circumstances, including "emergencies involving the safety of human life or the protection of property." 21 31 U.S.C. § 1342. Counsel for the United States has represented that Plaintiffs and Defendant 22 Intervenors do not oppose a stay under the circumstances. 23 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 24 (1) This action is STAYED until funding for Federal Defendants and their attorneys is 25 restored; 26 1
