16	Plaintiff Eugenio Luis Nogueras, a former state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma		
17	pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on August 21, 2012. The		
18	matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and		
19	Local Rule 302.		
20	On June 29, 2015, the Magistrate Judge recommended Defendant's motion for summary		
21	judgment for failure to exhaust be denied, with prejudice, on the ground that the exhaustion		
22	requirement does not apply to former prisoners who brought suit after their release. 42 U.S.C. §		
23	1997e(a); Talamantes v. Leyva, 575 F.3d 1021, 1024 (9th Cir. 2009). The fifteen-day objection		
24	period has expired and neither party filed objections.		
25	The Court has conducted a <i>de novo</i> review of this case pursuant to the provisions of 28		
26	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C). Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and		
27	Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1.	The Findings and Recommendations, filed on June 29, 2015, is adopted in full;
3	2.	Defendant's motion for summary judgment for failure to exhaust, filed on
4		November 7, 2014, is DENIED, with prejudice; and
5	3.	This matter is referred back to the Magistrate Judge to issue an amended scheduling
6		order.
