On January 28, 2014, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and 21 Recommendations which was served on Plaintiff and contained notice that Objections to the Findings and Recommendations were to be filed within ten days. On February 5, 2014, Plaintiff filed a non-22 23 opposition to the Findings and Recommendations. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and 25 26 Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis. 27 /// 28 ///

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed on January 28, 2014, is adopted in full; and
- 2. This action shall proceed solely on Plaintiff's First Amendment retaliation claim against Defendant R. Samuels and all other claims are DISMISSED, without leave to amend, for failure to state a cognizable claim.
