On September 28, 2012, the Court ordered Plaintiff either to file an 18 application to proceed in forma pauperis or to pay the filing fee in full within forty-five days. ECF 19 20 No. 6. As of the date of this order, Plaintiff has not responded. Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff is to show cause within **twenty-one** 21 (21) days why this action should not be dismissed for failure to obey a court order.
