ORDER DIRECTING CLERK'S OFFICE TO
SEND PLAINTIFF REGULAR CIVIL IFP
APPLICATION AND REQUIRING
PLAINTIFF TO FILE REGULAR CIVIL IFP
APPLICATION OR PAY FILING FEE IN
FULL WITHIN THIRTY DAYS

Plaintiff is a former state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed a motion seeking leave to proceed in forma pauperis by a prisoner on September 21, 2012. On October 4, 2012, Plaintiff filed a notice of change of address. In light of the fact that plaintiff is no longer in custody, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Clerk's Office shall send plaintiff a regular civil in forma pauperis application;
2. Within **thirty (30) days** from the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall either file a completed regular civil in forma pauperis application or pay the \$350.00 filing fee in full.

Failure to obey this order will result in dismissal of this action.
