5 with the following documents:

- 8 b. One completed USM-285 form for each Defendant; and
- 9 c. Six (6) copies of the complaint filed on August 20, 2012.

10 4. Plaintiff need not attempt service on Defendants and need not request waiver of
11 service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the Court will direct the United States
12 Marshal to serve the above-named Defendants pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4
13 without payment of costs.

14 5. The failure to comply with this Order will result in a Recommendation that this
15 action be dismissed.
