3	Defendant Job.com indicates that it is prepared to file a motion for summary judgment				
4	("MSJ") as to Plaintiff's individual claims within the next 30 days. Given that this motion may be				
5	dispositive of the entire case, it is more efficient that class discovery remain stayed and the motion				
6	for summary judgment be presented to the Court. Wright v. Schock, 742 F.2d 541, 544 (9th Cir.				
7	1984) ("It is reasonable to consider a Rule 56 motion first when early resolution of a motion for				
8	summary judgment seems likely to protect both parties and the court from needless and costly				
9	further litigation."). Further, although third-party Defendants Livecareer and Resumedirector				
10	indicate a desire to file a motion for judgment on the pleadings as to Defendant Job.com's third-				
11	party complaint, Job.com's MSJ has the potential to moot the motion for judgment on the				
12	pleadings. Thus, at this time, the Court sets only a schedule for Job.com to file its MSJ:
