ORDER DENYING MOTION TO STAY AND MOTION TO ADD CLAIMS
(Docs. 16, 19)

Petitioner's petition for writ of habeas corpus was dismissed as successive on March 7, 2013. After the matter was closed, Petitioner filed a motion to stay the matter while he filed claims in the California Supreme Court, and a motion to add claims. As the petition was dismissed as successive, this Court may only proceed with leave from the Ninth Circuit. (See ECF No. 6.) Neither of Petitioner's motions seek to obtain such relief from the Ninth Circuit. Accordingly, Petitioner's motions are DENIED.
