23	tampering with his legal mail and would like to file a motion.		
24	The Court DISREGARDS the instant letter, which cannot be construed as a motion.		
25	Moreover, the Court does not have information relating to Plaintiff's request slip sent from his place		
26	of incarceration. Plaintiff may file a motion for equitable relief if he believes that such a motion is		
27	necessary.
