Bryant, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on December 26, 2012. The matter was 18 19 referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 21 On May 29, 2015, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and Recommendations that recommended Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction be DENIED. The Findings and 22 23 Recommendations were served on all parties and contained notice that any objections were to be 24 filed within thirty (30) days. Over thirty days have passed and no party has filed objections. 25 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds that the 26

Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

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The Findings and Recommendations, filed May 29, 2015, are ADOPTED in full; and 1. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction is DENIED. IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/ Lawrence J. O'Neill
