Plaintiff Bryan D. Denton (“Plaintiff”), a county jail inmate proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on January 4, 2013. On June 13, 2014, Plaintiff filed an unsigned motion for summary judgment.¹ (ECF No. 30.) Unsigned filings cannot be considered by the Court and therefore, Plaintiff’s filing is ORDERED STRICKEN from the record. Fed. R. Civ. P. 11(a); Local Rule 131.
