4	2.	Defendants Zavala, Wibbles, and Taylor are dismissed from this action for	
5		Plaintiff's failure to state a claim against them;	
6	3. Plaintiff's Fifth and Ninth Amendment claims and Plaintiff's claim of being		
7		thrown to the ground are dismissed;	
8	4. This action proceeds against Defendant Chuna on Plaintiff's claim of deliberate		
9		indifference to his serious medical needs; and	
10	5.	Defendant Chuna is directed to file a response to the first amended complaint	
11		within thirty days of the date of service of this order.
