12 Steven Vlasich ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis*
13 with this civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The Court attempted to hold a
14 telephonic scheduling conference on November 13, 2017. (ECF No. 64). Counsel Jennifer
15 Marquez telephonically appeared on behalf of Defendants. Plaintiff failed to appear.

16 The Court has rescheduled the conference to December 12, 2017, at 10:30 a.m. (Id.).
17 Counsel for Defendants shall contact Plaintiff's institution of confinement to arrange for
18 Plaintiff's participation in this conference.

19 Additionally, Plaintiff will be required to explain why he did not participate in the
20 conference.

21 Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 22 1. Counsel for Defendants shall contact Plaintiff's institution of confinement to
23 arrange for Plaintiff's participation in the rescheduled conference; and
