9 Plaintiff, Juan Chavez, is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* in this civil
10 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On June 8, 2015, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting copies
11 of his and Defendants' motions for summary judgment. (Doc. 46.) Plaintiff indicates that he was
12 transferred from California Substance Abuse Treatment Facility in Corcoran, California to Centinela
13 State Prison in Imperial, California. (*Id.*) Though his legal materials were transferred with him,
14 portions have been damaged and are no longer legible. (*Id.*) Plaintiff indicates that he requires copies
15 of the motions for summary judgment filed in this case to assess whether a settlement conference
16 would be beneficial. (*Id.*)

17 Though it is unusual and not required to provide an inmate copies of documents that he has
18 previously been served and/or possessed, an exception will be made in this one instance.

19 Accordingly, it his **HEREBY ORDERED** that Plaintiff's motion to be served copies of the
20 motions for summary judgment in this case, filed on April 11, 2016, is **GRANTED** and the Clerk's
21 Office is directed to send Plaintiff a copy of both motions for summary judgment that were filed in this
22 action (Docs. 28, 36).
