16	Plaintiff filed a complaint on March 28, 2013, seeking judicial review of the Social Security
17	Commissioner's denial his application for social security disability benefits. Plaintiff also filed an
18	application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. (Doc. 4.) Plaintiff's
19	application reflects that he is employed, and his annual salary is approximately \$27,000. (Doc. 4.)
20	Because Plaintiff's application demonstrates that he is not entitled to proceed without prepayment
21	of fees, his application is DENIED. Within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, Plaintiff shall
22	either pay the \$350.00 filing fee or the case will be dismissed. This ADMONISHES plaintiff that
23	failure to comply with this order will result in dismissal of this action.
