23	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a		
24	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings		
25	and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.		
26	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

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1	2.	This action for damages shall proceed on Plaintiff's third amended complaint
2	against Defendants Hernandez, Mosqueda, and Baker for retaliation in violation of the Firs	
3	Amendment and endangering Plaintiff safety in violation of the Eighth Amendment;	
4	3.	Plaintiff's claims arising from the allegations set forth in paragraphs 10 through 13
5	are dismissed	l, with prejudice, for lack of standing and for failure to state a claim;
6	4.	Plaintiff's retaliation claim arising from the rules violation report issued by
7	Defendant Hernandez, to the extent one is alleged, is dismissed, without prejudice, for failure to	
8	state a claim;	
9	5.	Plaintiff's section 1983 equal protection claim and section 1985(3) claim are
10	dismissed, with prejudice, for failure to state a claim	
11	6.	Plaintiff's claims against Defendants Hudspeth and Biter are dismissed, with
12	prejudice, for failure to state a claim;	
13	7.	Plaintiff's request for declaratory relief is dismissed for failure to state a claim; and
14	8.	This matter is referred to the Magistrate Judge to initiate service of process.
