ORDER DISMISSING ACTION

16 Plaintiff is a former Stanislaus County Jail inmate proceeding pro se. Plaintiff seeks  
17 relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff has consented to magistrate judge jurisdiction  
18 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(1).

20 By order filed August 13, 2013, the operative complaint was dismissed for failure to state  
21 a claim. Plaintiff was granted leave to file an amended complaint, and directed to do so within  
22 thirty days. Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint.

23 In the August 13, 2013, order the Court informed Plaintiff of the deficiencies in his  
24 complaint, and dismissed the complaint on the ground that Plaintiff had failed to state a claim  
25 upon which relief could be granted. Because Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint, the  
26 Court dismisses the claims made in the original complaint with prejudice for failure to state a  
27 federal claim upon which the court could grant relief. See Noll v. Carlson, 809 F. 2d 1446, 1448
