3 and the Court being duly advised in the premises,

5 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:**

7 Plaintiff Katharine Graves' complaint is hereby dismissed without prejudice as
8 to Bank of America Corporation on the conditions set forth in this Stipulation;

10 Any future amended pleading against Bank of America Corporation for
11 violations of the California Fair Employment and Housing Act and the California
12 Family Rights Act (Govt. Code §§ 12900, 12940, 12945, 12945.2), and the Family and
13 Medical Leave Act (29 U.S.C. § 2601 *et seq.*), shall relate back to the original filing of
14 this action;

16 This stipulation does not constitute a waiver of, or otherwise impair, any
17 defenses Bank of America Corporation, Bank of America, N.A. or any other later-
18 named affiliated entity may raise against this action.
