19	On October 22, 2014, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and Recommendation	
20	recommending that Defendants' motion to dismiss Plaintiff's claim for monetary damages under the	
21	Religious Land Use and Institutionalized Persons Act (RLUIPA) be granted. The Findings and	
22	Recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice that objections were to file within	
23	thirty days. No objections were filed.	
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a d	
25	novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and	
26	Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.	
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Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1.
