

1 documents² for the purpose of complying with the Court's order to file his first amended complaint.
2 Id. at 1-2. In addition, Plaintiff indicates that he has informed five other prison officials of the need
3 for his property, but as of June 23, 2013, he has not received his legal documentation. Given the
4 nature of Plaintiff's confinement in the Ad. Seg., it appears that Plaintiff has made every effort to
5 comply with the Court's deadline. Therefore, the Court finds an exceptional showing of good cause to
6 grant an extension of time.

7 Accordingly, the Court **HEREBY GRANTS** Plaintiff up to and including **August 1, 2013**, in
8 which to file his first amended complaint. **No further extensions of time will be granted for**
9 **Plaintiff to file his first amended complaint. Plaintiff's failure to file his complaint on or before**
10 **August 1, 2013, shall result in an immediate dismissal of this matter.**
