On February 10, 2014, the parties filed a stipulation for an extension of time for Defendant to prepare and serve a response to Plaintiff's confidential letter brief. (Doc. 13.) Notably, the Scheduling Order allows a single thirty-day extension of time by the stipulation of parties, which has not been used by the parties. (*See* Doc. 5 at 4.)
