STIPULATION FOR REMAND  
PURSUANT TO SENTENCE FOUR  
OF 42 U.S.C. § 405(g)

20  
21 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by the parties, through their undersigned attorneys, and  
22 with the approval of the Court, that the Commissioner has agreed to a voluntary remand of this  
23 case for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of section 205(g) of the  
24 Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).

25 Upon remand, the Office of Disability Adjudication and Review will remand this case to  
26 an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) and direct him or her to re-evaluate Plaintiff's subjective  
27 complaints. The Appeals Council will also instruct the ALJ to evaluate whether Plaintiff has the  
28 residual functional capacity to perform a significant number of jobs in the national economy and,  
if appropriate, obtain supplemental vocational expert testimony to assist in determining what

1 jobs exist, if any, for Plaintiff given his age, education, vocational factors, and residual  
2 functional capacity. The ALJ will take any further action the ALJ deems necessary to develop  
3 the record and issue a new decision. Remand will be limited to the period before January 26,  
4 2011, the date on which Plaintiff was previously found disabled.
