ORDER DISMISSING ACTION

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16 Plaintiff is a former Merced County Jail inmate proceeding pro se. Plaintiff seeks relief
17 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff has consented to magistrate judge jurisdiction pursuant
18 to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(1).
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20 By order filed November 5, 2014, the operative complaint was dismissed for failure to
21 state a claim. Plaintiff was granted leave to file an amended complaint, and directed to do so
22 within thirty days. Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint.

23 In the November 5, 2014, order the Court informed Plaintiff of the deficiencies in his
24 complaint, and dismissed the complaint on the ground that Plaintiff had failed to state a claim
25 upon which relief could be granted. Because Plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint, the
26 Court dismisses the claims made in the original complaint with prejudice for failure to state a
27 federal claim upon which the court could grant relief. See Noll v. Carlson, 809 F. 2d 1446, 1448

1 (9th Cir. 1987) (prisoner must be given notice of deficiencies and opportunity to amend prior to
2 dismissing for failure to state a claim).

3 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is dismissed for failure to state
4 a claim upon which relief can be granted. The Clerk is directed to close this case.
