17	This matter arises out of the death of David Silva which, it is claimed, was caused by the		
18	application of excessive and unreasonable use of force by various law enforcement officers. Minor		
19	Plaintiff J.S. is a surviving child of the decedent, and seeks approval of the settlement reached with		
20	Defendants, by and through her mother and guardian ad litem Adriane Dominguez. (Doc. 248) On		
21	August 2, 2016, the magistrate judge recommended the settlement be approved, and the funds		
22	distributed as proposed by the parties. (Doc. 251)		
23	The parties were given fourteen days to file any objections to the recommendation. (Doc. 251		
24	at 6) In addition, the parties were "advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may		
25	waive the right to appeal the District Court's order." (Id., citing Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th		
26	Cir. 1991)). To date, no objections have been filed.		
27	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(C) and Britt v. Simi Valley United		
28	School Dist., 708 F.2d 452, 454 (9th Cir. 1983), this Court conducted a de novo review of the case.		

1	Having carefully reviewed the file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations are supported		
2	by the record and proper analysis.		
3	Accordingly, <b>IT IS HEREBY ORDERED</b> :		
4	1.	The Findings and Recommendations dated August 2, 2016 (Doc. 251) are ADOPTED	
5		IN FULL;	
6	2.	The petitions to approve settlement of the J.S. claims (Docs. 239, 248) are GRANTED;	
7	3.	The County of Kern is <b>DIRECTED</b> to pay \$158,400 to "ADRIANE DOMINGUEZ, as	
8		the Guardian Ad Litem for JADE SILVA, a minor, in trust to the Law Office of John L.	
9		Burris";	
10	4.	The State of California be <b>DIRECTED</b> to pay \$21,600 to "ADRIANE DOMINGUEZ,	
11		as the Guardian Ad Litem for JADE SILVA, a minor, in trust to the Law Office of John	
12		L. Burris";	
13	5.	The request for attorneys' fees in the amount of \$45,000 and costs (in the amount of	
14		\$2,866.30), is <b>APPROVED</b> ;	
15	6.	Of the settlement amount, \$10,695.98 SHALL be disbursed immediately by the Law	
16		Office of John Burris to Adriane Dominguez to pay for ballet lessons, a laptop	
17		computer and orthodontia services for the child. The remainder of the settlement	
18		proceeds, \$121,437.72, SHALL be placed in an interest-bearing blocked trust account	
19		at an FDIC insured banking institution for the benefit of J.S. This amount will be	
20		disbursed to J.S. on her 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday; and	
21	7.	The parties <b>SHALL</b> file a stipulation for dismissal of the action with prejudice, and	
22		lodge a separate order, within ten days of the date of service of this Order.
