Individuals detained pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions Code § 20 6600 et seg. are civil detainees and are not prisoners within the meaning of the Prison 21 Litigation Reform Act. Page v. Torrey, 201 F.3d 1136, 1140 (9th Cir. 2000). 22 On July 15, 2013, Plaintiff filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 23 2) using an improper form. This application shall be disregarded. 24 On August 9, 2013, Plaintiff filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF 25 No. 8) utilizing the correct form, revealing Plaintiff is unable to afford the costs of this action. 26 This application shall be granted. 27 Accordingly, for the reasons stated, it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT (1) the July 15,

2013 application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 2) is DISREGARDED, and (2) the
