Plaintiff is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on July 25, 2013.<sup>1</sup>

On December 4, 2014, Plaintiff filed a request for an extension of time concerning Defendant’s motion to strike Plaintiff’s unauthorized sur-replies.
