

1 parties. The time has expired for any person to file an administrative claim to the currency
2 under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2), and no person other than the Potential Claimant has filed an
3 administrative claim to the currency in the administrative forfeiture proceeding.

4 3. On August 6, 2013, the United States filed a civil judicial "Verified Complaint
5 for Forfeiture In Rem," in the Eastern District of California: *United States v. Approximately*
6 *\$93,500.00 in U.S. Currency*, Docket No. 1:13-CV-01225-AWI-SKO, ECF No. 1.

7 4. As provided by 18 U.S.C. § 981(g)(2), the Potential Claimant requested a stay
8 of the civil forfeiture proceedings, and on August 27, 2013, the Court issued an order
9 staying the instant action and set a status conference for February 3, 2013. The parties
10 were to file a Joint Status Report one week prior to the status conference. Doc. # 7.

11 5. The parties wish by agreement to extend the stay for thirty-days, as the
12 parties are currently in settlement discussions.

13 6. Accordingly, the parties request that the stay be extended to March 3, 2014.
14 The parties will file a joint status report one week prior, informing the court whether the
15 continuation of the stay is still necessary.
